



## Rosmini Community School Acceptable Use Policy

### Important updates for Remote Learning.

#### **Remote Learning (Updated 21st April 2020)**

Our nominated platform for online classes is Google Meet. Our Code of Behaviour applies to remote learning in the same manner as traditional classroom learning. Only students of Rosmini Community School are permitted to join/ partake in Google Meet classes.

Any breach in school rules pertaining to Google Meet classes may result in students being refused access to further remote classes pending an investigation by the school. Following that investigation, any established breach in school rules will be managed in line with the code of behaviour.

#### Below is a list of the school rules pertaining to Google Meet classes:

- Student cameras MUST be turned off for the class duration. This assists levels of bandwidth during the Google Meet.
- Student microphones MUST be turned off until question time during the lesson. This eliminates distracting background noise. This 'question time' will be done in an orderly fashion by the teacher/s.
- Students are not permitted to record Google Meet lessons on any device.
- Students must exit the class at the end of the Meet in an orderly fashion as arranged by the teacher/s. The last person to leave Google Meet is the teacher on every occasion.
- The 'Chat function' in Google Meet is limited exclusively to the content on teaching and learning.
- Communication on the Google Platform is restricted to the student and the teacher only.
