# Cancellation of Examinations

Teachers use a range of information to calculate a percentage mark using tests, mocks and homework

> To ensure the process was done correctly, teachers meet with the Deputy Principal / another teacher of that subject

> > Principal double-checks that the process is done correctly

What informs the teacher's estimated mark & Rankings?



Examinations with more than one component – Teachers give the usual weighting that is used for the Leaving Certificate

E.g. Music

50% Practical – based on what you've learning of the students over the last two years

25% Listening - based on what you've learning of the students over the last two years

25% Composing - based on what you've learning of the students over the last two years

# Subject-Specific Issues

# Languages



Based them on the assumption that the oral examination component would have proceeded as usual



100% for orals does not apply now

Reasonable Accommodations for SEN Students

Teacher will base their estimate of the student's likely performance on the assumption that this accommodation would have been available

In relation to alignment - the SEN teacher can be part of this process

## Confirm Subject Levels

Subjects you were due to sit and the levels you confirmed back in February It is essential that you confirm your levels now so that your school can complete our task of estimating a percentage and a rank order



# BE CAREFUL

If you confirm a level that is higher than the level that you have been planning for – it is likely to lead to a lower than anticipated grade in that subject



# Confirm Subject Levels

The system will not allow a change of level to a higher level.

### What if I am not changing level?

Even if you are not making any changes to the levels you must confirm the subject level information presented
