- These courses will enable students to develop first aid response, health and safety and other key skills and training that will prepare them for the working world.
- The skills that students will learn over the course of the week will allow them to undertake a greater variety of work in the future.

Monday 8th February 2021

Emergency First Aid: 08.50am-3.40pm

Students will learn valuable skills around how to act in an emergency. They will explore how to apply this knowledge and training a variety of emergency scenarios.

Tuesday 9th February 2021

Health and Safety for the Workplace Level 1: 08.50am-10.50am

Health and Safety for the Workplace Level 2: 08.50am-3.40pm

Students will receive an introduction to Health and Safety. They will learn about the importance Health and Safety rules and regulations in the workplace. Students will become aware of potential hazards and risks to the safety of employers, employees, and customers in the world of work. They will examine the protocols in controlling common hazards in the workplace. They will know the procedures involved in the system of reporting a Health and Safety concern.

Wednesday 10th February 2021

Manual Handling for TY: 08.50am-11.45am)

This course is designed to equip students in correct lifting and handling techniques .There will be a focus on the need for good posture and emphasise the need for safe practice in the Workplace. Manual Handling Training is a legal requirement for businesses. Students will undertake an assessment to complete this course.

Thursday 11th February 2021

HACCP Basic Food Hygiene: 08.50am-11.45am

This course is designed to train students in proper food safety procedures and the HACCP system. There will be a focus on hand washing, HACCP principles and most importantly how to use the HACCP in the workplace. HACCP Food safety is a legal requirement for businesses handling food. Students will undertake a theory assessment to complete this course.

Fire Safety Training: 12.25-3.40pm

This course is designed to equip students in how to deal with a fire. There will be a focus on Extinguisher Operation, legislative requirements and most importantly how to deal with a fire. Friday 12th February 2021

Covid-19 Work Experience Induction Course: 08.50am-11.45am
